

Title: Departmental Limitations in the University Core	Policy No: 1.15 Effective: Fall 2005

Policy Statement: A department/school (except where the department/school includes various disciplines) can have courses in no more than two areas of the university core.

Background: This policy was recommended by the Academic Affairs Curriculum Council as it reviewed courses to be included in the University Core. Examples of departments/schools housing various disciplines include: Department of Humanities and Philosophy, Department of History and Geography, Department of Sociology, Gerontology, and Substance Abuse Studies. Fields of study do not constitute separate disciplines.

Purpose: Assure breadth in student degree requirements.

Implementation Date: Fall 2005

Related Procedures: Academic Affairs Curriculum Council will monitor as courses are approved for inclusion in the University Core.
