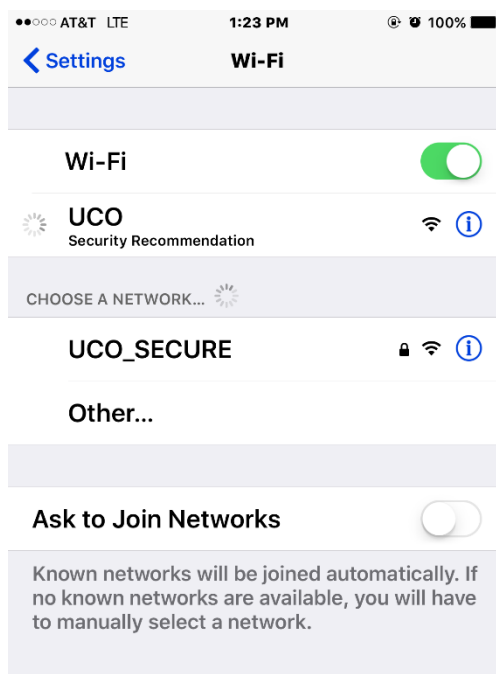


# UCO Wi-Fi Guest Pass Guide (iPhone)

Guests of UCO must self-register their own devices upon arrival on campus. No advanced planning is required. Each individual guest requests their own unique wireless guest pass upon arriving on campus. In addition to agreeing to UCO’s Technology and Network Usage Policy, guests will need to be able to provide their name, email address, telephone number, cellular provider and the reason for their visit.

## Step 1: Connect to the **UCO** wireless network.

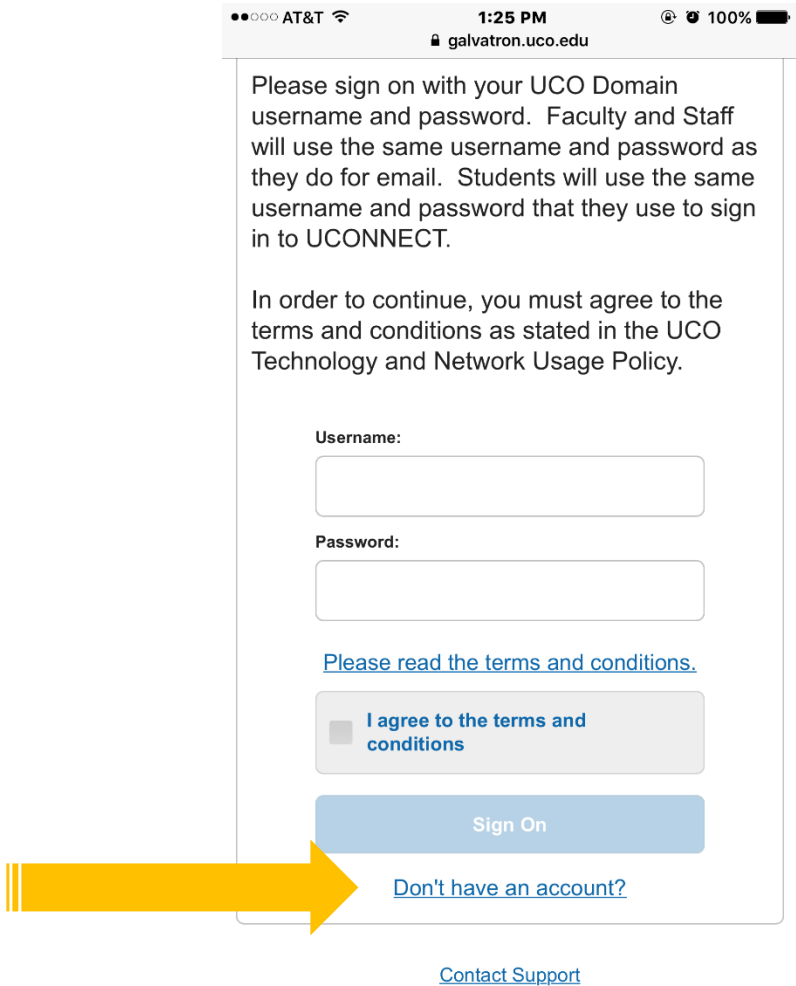

**STEP 2:** Open a NEW web page in the web browser on your device. \* **IMPORTANT:** You cannot just open your browser – you must open a NEW web page! When you do so, you will then be automatically redirected to the UCO Login Page.

If you do not see the UCO Login Page, type the address 1.1.1.1 in the browser to force the UCO Login Page to appear in the browser.

Since you are a guest, you do not have a UCO username and password -- so click the "Don't have an account?" link below the Sign On button.

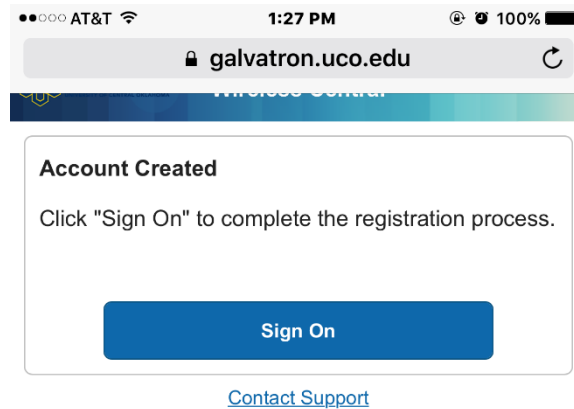
