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### Required Courses for the OUHSC Pre-Dental Hygiene Program

#### Non-Science:

English Composition I and English Composition II (6 hrs); Public Speaking or Communication Principles (3 hrs); General Psychology (3 hrs); Foreign Language (6 hrs or 2 years of high school foreign language); Intro to Sociology (3 hrs); U.S History (3 hrs); Understanding Artistic Forms (3 hrs)\*, Western Civilization & Culture (3 hrs)\*, Non-Western Culture (3 hrs)\*, Electives to make up the balance needed to equal 60 hours (with at least one upper division General Education course)\*

\*These courses are not required if you have already received a bachelor's degree.

**Minimum Admission Requirements:** Admission to the Dental Hygiene Program is competitive. Selection is based on the applicant's post-secondary academic record, life experiences and the potential for success in a baccalaureate program of study in dental hygiene. Oklahoma residents are given preference, but well-qualified non-residents are also considered for admission. New students are admitted for the fall semester only. To be considered for admission, students must meet the following requirements:

1. Submit a completed University of Oklahoma Health Sciences center application with application fee, a Dental Hygiene Supplemental Application form, official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended or currently enrolled, two (2) letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with applicant's potential for success, such as a college science instructor and recent employer. All application materials must be submitted by **January 15<sup>th</sup>** of the year in which admission is sought. A fall transcript is required with application. Ideally, all FOUNDATIONAL courses will have been completed prior to the January 15<sup>th</sup> deadline, and all prerequisite courses must be completed by the end of the spring semester.
2. Be in good standing with the college or university last attended.
3. Take the ACT or SAT on a **national test date** and provide individual component scores and composite score.
4. Have successfully completed or will have completed prior to entry into the program the courses listed on this form. Have a total minimum of sixty (60) semester hours of coursework from any accredited college or university. It is the responsibility of the student to submit official transcripts for courses taken after the application deadline.
5. Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale with a grade of C or better on all specifically required courses.
6. If English is the student's second language, a national standardized TOEFL examination is required.
7. Interviews are conducted on an individual basis. Selected individuals will be notified and arrangements made for personal interview. Interview does not indicate acceptance into the program. All expenses incurred in the interview process will be the responsibility of the applicant.
8. Applicants are required to observe dental hygienists in the workplace for a minimum of 40 hours (observation of a dentist does NOT meet this requirement).
