Eligibility: Any individual or organization engaged in collaborative activities with members of the college community.

Criteria:

Nominees should demonstrate the following characteristics:

- ❖ Demonstrated outstanding contributions through collaborating with college members in a way that benefits students and the communities served by the college.
- ❖ Consistent contributions over a period of at least three years of activity
- ❖ Evidence of accomplishment as measured by pertinent patterns of evidence related to impact on students and the community

Nominations are to be completed by the nominator after consulting with the community partner to be nominated. Self-nominations are not accepted. Nominations are to be turned in to the CEPS Dean's Office by **Monday, March 4, 2019**. Late nominations will not be accepted.

Award:

Certificate of Award to be given at the CEPS Awards Reception on Friday, April 19, 2019 and name added to plaque in administration offices of the college.

3. Additional documentation may be requested by the Awards and Recognition Committee as needed to support nomination. Documentation may include evidence of activity or contribution.
